However, we want to assure you that, as the summer days go by, the teachers will be ready to offer in September a warm and welcoming environment to all children and new comers.

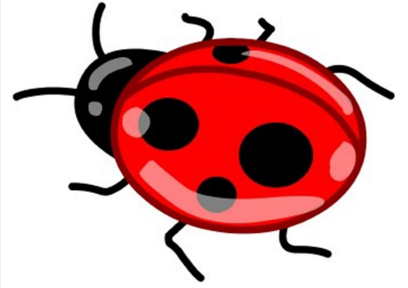
Our last academic theme was about insects and summer. Children learned about the insects as well as the different characteristics of the summer season and the various activities that they can engage in during this time of year.



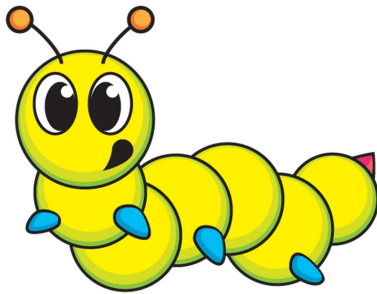
A butterfly
