All classes were provided with posters, charts, plastic figurines of farm animals and many animal puzzles and games.

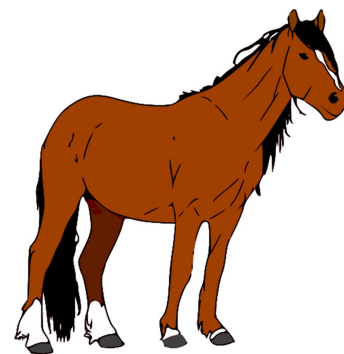
Children learned characteristics of the farm animals such as:

Some farm animals visited the nursery: children got the opportunity to pet them, to feed them, to see how they move and recognize their babies.



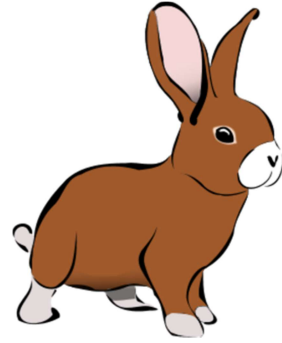

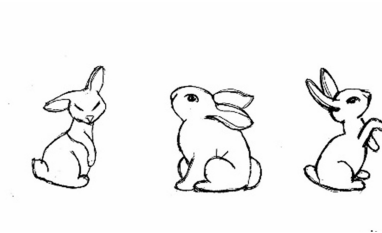
Children also learned about farm animals’ products, and were amazed by the fact that most of the food items are products of farm animals.



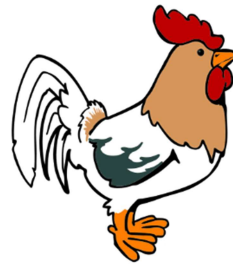
The whole month, children listened to the sounds of animals and tried to imitate them and learned by observing them that animals:

or jump such as rabbits do

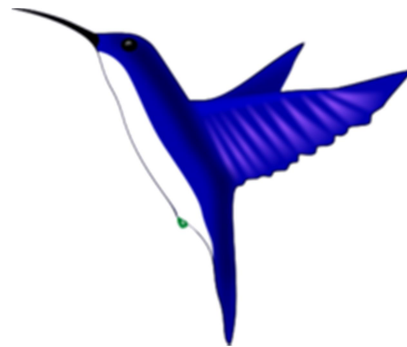


or simply walk and run such as roosters do.

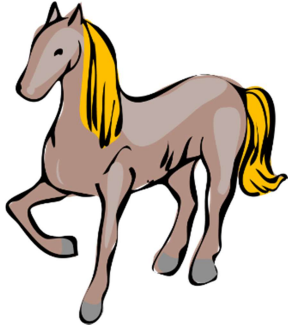
Children compared opposites such as:



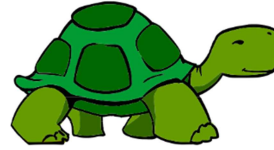
Fat
