







Furthermore, kids enjoyed smelling all kinds of hidden items and had to associate them to their correspondent fruit!

This is how kids learnt the five senses while enjoying fun games, and while having all their sensory skills stimulated.

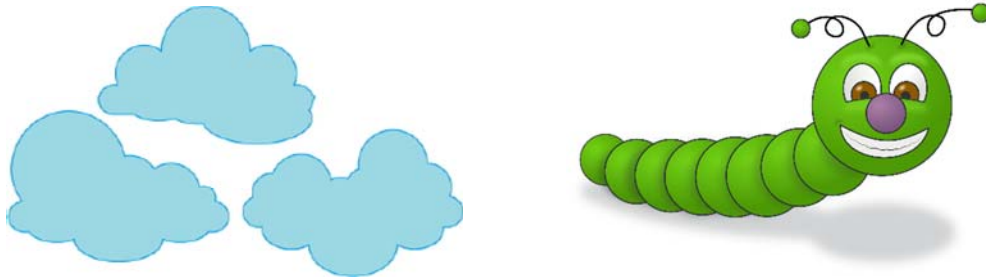

First, a new vocabulary word was introduced:

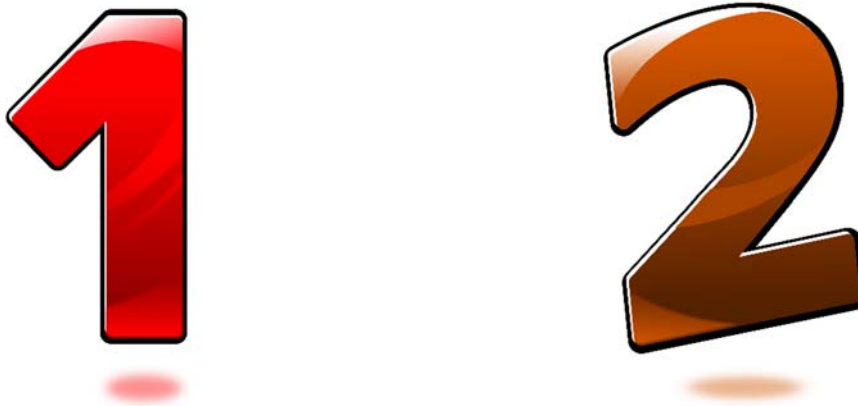
 <p>Soap</p>	 <p>Shampoo</p>
