


Dear Mom and Dad,



During language sessions, we enjoyed listening to many stories related to the theme.


We are now able to differentiate between "boy", and "girl".



As a 2 year old, I was exposed to the letter A, such as: An Apple




As a 3 year old, in addition to the letter A, I was exposed also to the letter "B", such as: A Banana

As a 3 year old, in addition to the color red, I was exposed also to the yellow and orange colors






<u>Math:</u>
