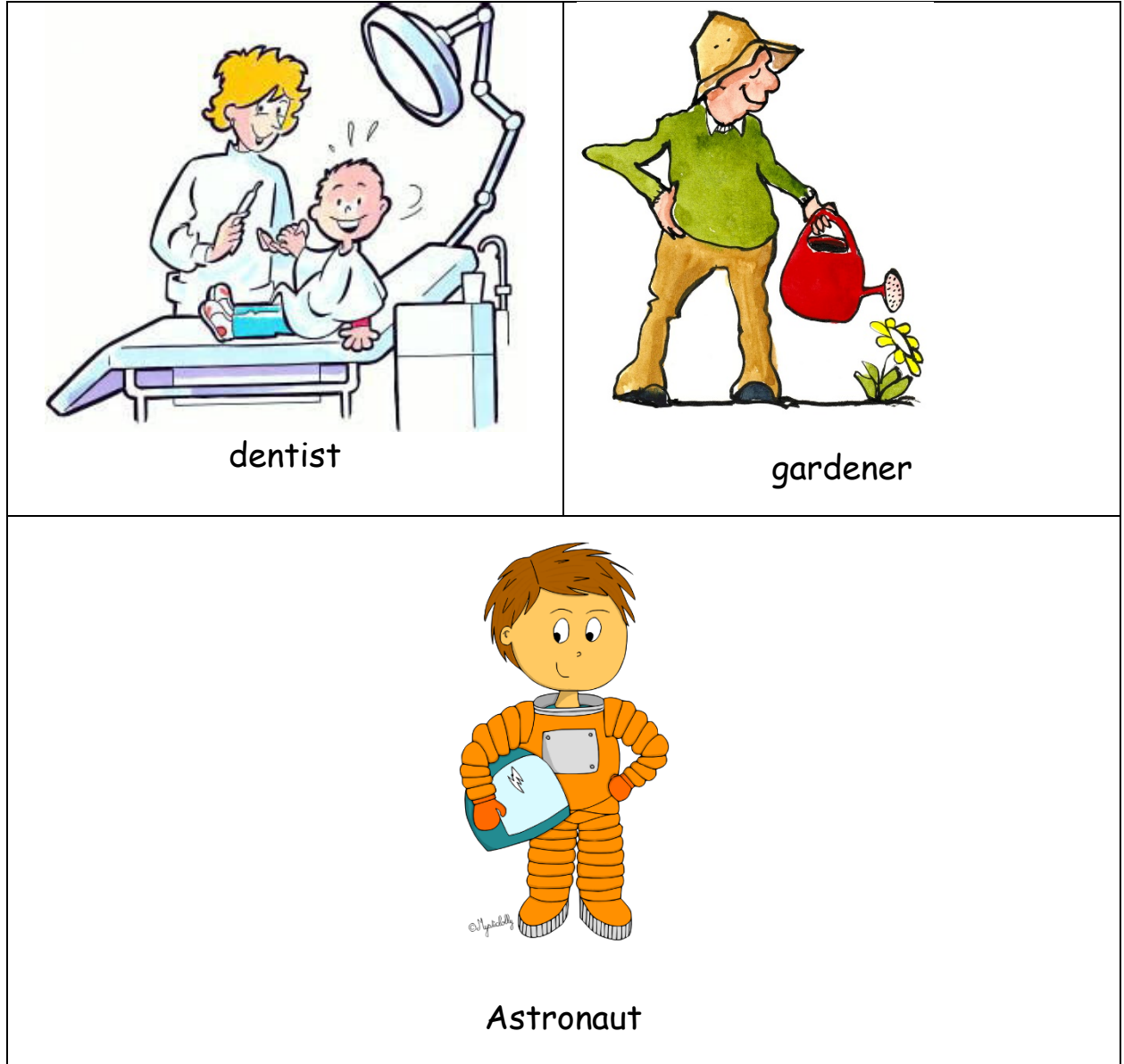
Kids of 2 to 3 years old got also the opportunity to learn about few community helpers and appreciate their work in the community.

ball



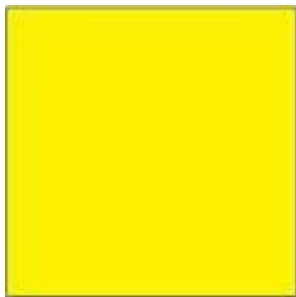

Montessori new techniques were practiced such as:

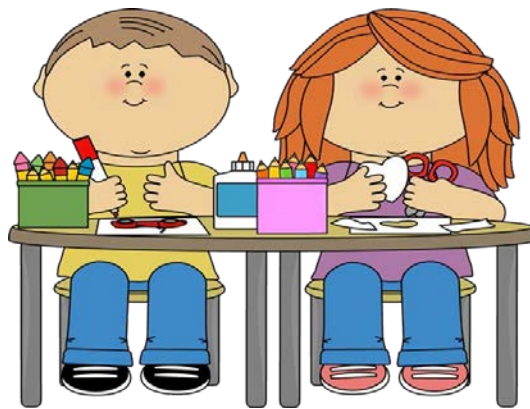

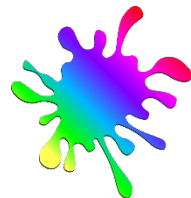
